

NAIC POLICY STATEMENT ON SPONSORSHIPS

Neither the National Association of Insurance Commissioners or its zones shall solicit, accept or use funds, or any kind of sponsorship, from any entity, individual or corporate holding company which is subject to regulation pursuant to the insurance statutes and laws of the various member jurisdictions of the NAIC for the purpose of providing social events, meals, gifts or facilities in conjunction with any of the association's meetings. Furthermore, a member whose jurisdiction is the location of one of the association's meetings agrees to honor this policy when acting in the capacity of "host" commissioner.
