

NAIC National Meeting Frequently Asked Questions

Schedule Changes.

Q: How will I know about any last minute changes to the Meetings Schedule?

A: Any additions/deletions to the NAIC printed program will be posted at NAIC Registration.

Message Center.

Q: Can someone leave a message for me while I am attending the meeting? Where would I go to receive the message?

A: Messages for attendees will be received at the Message Center during registration hours. Messages will be posted on the bulletin board near NAIC Registration.

Open Meetings.

Q: Are all meetings open to registered meeting attendees?

A: It is NAIC practice that meetings listed in this program are public and open to all registered attendees, unless specific attendance restrictions are described. However, a chairperson can designate all or part of the meeting as "*Regulator to Regulator*" (attendance restricted to state insurance department personnel and state legislators).

Spouses or guests are not permitted to attend any meetings if they are a member of the industry themselves unless they are paid registrants.

Q: I have attended previous NAIC National meeting, does my old name badge allow me to attend current meeting?

A: A current name badge is required for entry to NAIC sessions. Use of a badge from a previous meeting will result in a ban of attending any future national meeting.

Q: Do I have to turn off my cell phone or blackberry while I attend meetings?

A: To avoid disruption of the meeting, please refrain from using cell phones in the meeting room and put beepers and cell phones on "mute." Please note: use of Blackberrys or similar devices will often interfere and create static with microphone/audio systems.
